Legacy of Caring 2007-2022

The story of what makes Aurora House so special is the LOVE that created this house. Dr. Rafael Rodriguez, then a Medical Director for a local hospice, in his service for his patients -many of whom were living in extreme poverty and without resources or families who could take care them, dreamed of bringing end of life comfort and peace to the most vulnerable in our community. Through the generosity and dedication of many donors and volunteers, the dream of Aurora House became a reality. And now 15 years later, we have evolved into a ten bedroom Licensed Special Care Facility providing a home-like environment with quality care for the terminally ill and educational opportunities for students through our Education Center for Palliative Care. Caring for patients and their families at the end of their lives is truly a privilege for us. There is something about someone entrusting you with the last months, weeks, days of their lives that is very profound and moving - it is not taken lightly, and we at Aurora House have cared for over 1200 patients and their families from all over the Rio Grande Valley. Aurora House gives families moments and memories, creating better endings since our doors opened in 2007.



As we celebrate 15 years at Aurora House, we so grateful for the support from our community, our amazing staff, and Board of Directors through the years. We are so blessed to have such a wonderful village of businesses, organizations, and individuals who give us the support to continue our mission in helping patients and families face end of life with peace, now and in the future. 


Memorial Gifts
